

Isolino Virginia and Lake Varese

Departure for Biandronno/Gavirate: boat trip to Isolino Virginia, a splendid natural oasis declared a Unesco World Heritage. Isolino Virginia, located in Lake Varese, was inhabited since the early Neolithic (7th - 6th millennium BC), until the Bronze Age (approximately 10th century BC), and during this long period man often had to adapt or change the location of settlements on the island due to fluctuations in lake water levels. An outdoor educational tour complete with guide. An outline of remains along the coast and two excavation cross-sections on display in the Museum provide visitors with information on the 5th millennium settlement. Lunch at a typical restaurant on the island, return: Varese railway station and hotel.
